BMX Bike Track

In May 2005 Council approved a conceptual plan for a BMX Bike Track to be built adjacent to Balmoral Oval along with improvement works to the adjoining creeks. A condition of the Development Consent

was that possible site contamination issues needed to be investigated which resulted in findings by two specialist consultant companies that the site needed to be remediated prior to use as a BMX Bike Track. These issues have delayed the development of the plan and the building of the track..

Council staff recommended in a report to the 3 July meeting of Council that remediation work be undertaken, that no further action be taken in the construction of the BMX track, and that the area be replanted as bushland. Council however resolved that prior to considering the matter further, the community be consulted. A copy of the report can be found on Council's website www.mosman.nsw.gov.au The report estimated the cost to remediate the site and to undertake creek work is \$270,000 and a further \$205,000 for the BMX track. Council has set aside an amount of \$108,462 (being a shortfall of \$96,538) towards the cost of the BMX track which includes a grant from NSW Sport and Recreation for \$45,000. Council officers have now recommended that this money be redistributed to other sporting facilities in the area such as improvements to floodlights and cricket nets identified within the Mosman Sporting Facilities Capital Works Program. The remediation works are funded from other sources. Submissions to the General Manager on this proposal are welcome and will be received up until 14 September 2007.

Temporary Closure of Hordern Lane on Tues 31 July from 7am to 5pm

The loading and drop off/pick up zones in Hordern Lane will be unavailable all day due to urgent repair work on a building. Affected businesses are required to make alternative arrangements for delivery of goods and services to and from the lane. Road closure points will be manned by RTA accredited traffic controllers and emergency service vehicle access will be maintained at all times.
