3.	<p>Active Transport Strategy</p> <p>Strategy to cover aims which are consistent with MOSPLAN</p> <p>Aims including increasing safety for pedestrians and cyclists by reducing speed in local streets to 40km/h and intersection treatments.</p> <p>Increase local trips by walking and cycling – possibly starting with school children. Examine routes to school, linking schools to residential precincts.</p> <p>Goals Safety More active residents</p> <p>Focus 40km/h areas Local trips to shops, school and recreational walking Intersection treatments for pedestrians and traffic calming especially those that are dangerous on the above routes.</p> <p>Areas/routes to be investigated and prioritised.</p> <p>Possibility of shared footpath zones for pedestrians and cyclists on Spit/Military Roads to Belmont Road.</p> <p>Aspiration could be – 30km/h on shopping strip, school zones, Balmoral and other sensitive areas.</p>	Noted
