Policy Details:

Policy for low, medium and high intensity seasonal commercial use licences for Council's public reserves (not otherwise provided for in the Pricing Policy).

Council will assess applications for low, medium and high intensity seasonal commercial use licences for its public reserves (not otherwise provided for in the Pricing Policy) in accordance with this policy.

Community/not for profit use will be charged at 30% of the commercial rate and public/education/leisure use will be charged at 60% of the commercial rate.

The intensity of the activities are to be measured and determined in accordance with the following policy:

Low Intensity Use

Low Intensity activities include some or all of the following:

- Minimal set-up requirements
- Utilise a small portion of the hired area
- Do not generate a lot of noise
- Take place for no more than 10 hours per week
- Conducted in an area that is not highly utilised.

Medium Intensity Use

Medium Intensity activities include some or all of the following:

- Minimal set up requirements
- Take place between 10 to 15 hours per week
- Utilise a small portion of the hire area
- Do not generate a lot of noise
- Conducted in an area that is not highly utilised.

OR

POLICY REGISTER

- Considerable set up requirements
- Take place less than 10 hours per week
- Utilise a reasonable portion of the hired area
- Generates some noise
- Conducted in an area that is regularly utilised.

High Intensity Use

High Intensity activities include some or all of the following:

- Considerable set up requirements
- Take place more than 15 hours per week
- Utilise a reasonable portion of the hire area
- Generates some noise
- Conducted in an area that is regularly utilised
