New parking area, upgrading of the laneway and footpaths adjacent to the commercial district March/April 2019 Laneway closure

New paving and landscaping with trees and garden beds adjacent the commercial district May/June 2019





The **first stage** commenced in October 2018 and included a new bus bay, bus shelter and levelling the road to allow for a new paved laneway. This also enabled traffic calming in the area. Thirteen car spaces situated adjacent to the foreshore were removed to be replaced in the second stage. There will be no net loss of car parking.

The **end of stage one** saw new bike hoops and seats erected along the foreshore as well as the landscaping of new garden beds and trees.

The **second stage** began in early March 2019 and will include upgrades to the existing laneway and footpaths as well as including a new parking area and new loading zones. There will be limited access through the existing laneway from March until June.

The **end of stage two** will see new paving adjacent to the Spit East commercial district as well as landscaping of new garden beds.

Overall there will be seven trees removed during these works and 21 new trees planted.

There will be pedestrian access to all businesses and the foreshore during the works and the Spit East Car Park will operate as normal.
