6. Mosman Council Climate Action Project Update

SS – Advised two new 50 kW charges to be ready for use by end of the week at Raglan West carpark.

Conversation on private power cords over nature strips to charge cars. Advised current trials in Melbourne for Pop-Up chargers on Council land; growing demand for residents to install chargers in the street. At this stage Council is not investigating further and will not permit power cords across Council land. Confirmed Council is currently providing access to chargers on Council land only.

7.	Advised Ausgrid are transforming electrical boxes with advertising into EV charging points, this option has been adopted by Northern Beaches Council. Council does not believe it meets planning controls so it will not be pursued further. Advised LED conversions on Marie Bashir Sports Centre to be completed late December. Solar installation finished at Depot and hoping to have installation of solar system on Civic Centre early 2023. JL – Suggested adoption of Biodiesel for Council Motor Vehicle fleet where possible. PM – Provided update on Operation Posidonia seagrass trials and pending installation of living seawall at Ellery Park. Advised that a tour of SIMS can be arranged. General Business SS raised a suggestion from CB asking if the meeting could be moved to 8:30am.
