Feedback session	<p>What has gone well and what could be improved.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Once/year have a meeting in the Great Hall- a community meeting of people who want to be part of the conversation. - Have a range of different opportunities, online, focus groups, day, evening, as accessible as possible. - An additional loose group of people who can work together and collaborate to provide ongoing support, broad access and support. - Finding a group of people who want to be involved can be a challenge. May be people who are interested. - There are very few services based in Mosman directly. - Celebrating, sharing stories, good news stories. - Chandra and Steve have been responsive and proactive in making improvements to the lived environment a priority. - There has been 100 little wins, and we have achieved much. - Discussed opportunities for the Committee to add more agenda items.

Broadens inclusion to mental health and psychosocial support. Inclusion covers all needs. - This group has worked well and have achieved a lot, with really effective discussions. It moves slowly but so much has happened. - Andrew: Speak with Ann specifically was around her concern about the pavements. - Committee members will be formally asked to provide feedback on the committee.
