



KERB ONLY

SCALE 1:10




KERBING NOTES

- 1. ALL CONCRETE TO HAVE A MINIMUM COMPRESSIVE STRENGTH OF 32MPa U.N.O.
- 2. ALL KERBS, GUTTERS, DISH DRAINS AND CROSSINGS TO BE CONSTRUCTED ON MINIMUM 100mm GRANULAR BASECOURSE COMPACTED TO MINIMUM 95% MODIFIED DRY DENSITY (AS 1289 5.2.1) OR 100mm 5MPa MASS CONCRETE.
- 3. EXPANSION JOINTS (E.J) TO BE FORMED FROM 10mm COMPRESSIBLE CORK FILLER BOARD FOR THE FULL DEPTH OF THE SECTION AND CUT TO PROFILE. EXPANSION JOINTS TO BE LOCATED AT DRAINAGE PITS, ON TANGENT POINTS OF CURVES AND ELSEWHERE AT MAX. 6m CENTRES EXCEPT FOR INTEGRAL KERBS WHERE THE EXPANSION JOINTS ARE TO MATCH THE JOINT LOCATIONS IN THE SLABS.
- 4. WEAKENED PLANE JOINTS TO BE MIN. 3mm WIDE AND LOCATED AT 3m CENTRES EXCEPT FOR INTEGRAL KERBS WHERE THE WEAKENED PLANE JOINTS ARE TO MATCH THE JOINT LOCATIONS IN THE SLABS.
- 5. IN THE REPLACEMENT OF KERB AND GUTTER:EXISTING ROAD PAVEMENT IS TO BE SAWCUT 600mm U.N.O FROM THE LIP
 OF GUTTER. UPON COMPLETION OF THE NEW KERB AND GUTTER NEW
 BASECOURSE AND SURFACE TO BE LAID 600mm WIDE U.N.O.
- 6. EXISTING ALLOTMENT DRAINAGE PIPES ARE TO BE BUILT INTO THE NEW KERB AND GUTTER WITH 75x125mmx5 GALV. RHS
- 7. EXISTING KERB AND GUTTER IS TO BE COMPLETELY REMOVED WHERE NEW KERB AND GUTTER IS SHOWN.
