Mosman's Community Strategic Plan, known as MOSPLAN, reflects the aspirations of the Mosman community and its elected Council and also takes into account an extensive range of other strategies and plans prepared by Council to address specific service areas or issues. It aims to ensure that services can be delivered to the Mosman community in a manner that is effective, efficient and planned in a logical and financially sustainable way. MOSPLAN articulates a long-term vision for Mosman's future, and details through a Resourcing Strategy, Delivery Program, Operational Plan and Budget how Council intends to deliver on that Vision across 10, 4 and 1 year horizons.
14	Update MOSPLAN Reference	The results of Council's 2024 2023 Community Survey (an independent survey of 400 401 randomly selected residents) demonstrated that 99% of residents consider their quality of life as good to excellent and 96 93% believe that people in Mosman are generally proud of their area.
